



Privacy statement Stichting Haarlem Jamborette

General

This privacy statement describes how Stichting Haarlem Jamborette (hereinafter the “Foundation” or “we”) handles and protects personal data (hereinafter the “data”) we learn about or obtain from (future) participants and volunteers of our international scouting camp the Haarlem Jamborette 2027 (hereinafter the “Jambo”).

The Foundation considers it of great importance that the collection and processing of the data takes place in a careful and secure manner. We advise you to read this privacy statement carefully. We have done our best to make this explanation as brief and easy to understand as possible.

What data do we collect?

We may collect and process the following data:

- Information such as name, address details, date of birth, place of birth, gender, phone number, email address, national identification number (*in Dutch: burgerservicenummer*) and name and country of your scouting group.
- Payment and billing information such as a billing address.
- Information about special diets and medical requirements.
- Items publicly posted by you such as posts on social media sites managed by us.
- Pictures and video recordings.

How do we collect data?

We may collect data in the following ways:

- Directly from you, for instance, when you sign up for our newsletter, send an email, create a Jambo-account and submit data or post items on social media sites managed by us.
- At the campsite of the Jambo and during activities outside the campsite pictures and video recordings may be made for promotional purposes.

How and why do we use the data?

We do not process the data without reason. We require the data to be able to organize the Jambo. To be able to collect camp fees and other payments, for example. We also require your data to inform you about activities before, during and after the Jambo, to implement legal regulations and to answer your questions.

We must be able to base the use of the data on one of the legal bases. Under Dutch law, it is permitted, among others, to process your data if this is required for organizing the Jambo, when you have given us your consent to process your data or if the data processing is required because we have a legitimate interest or because of a legal requirement.

Is the data processed automatically?

No. Automated processing of data means that decisions are made by computer programs or systems, without involving a human being. We do not do that.

With whom do we share the data?

First of all, we do not sell the data. We only use and share the data with third-parties (including government agencies and other authorized bodies) where permitted or even required by Dutch law for organizing the Jambo.

With any third-parties that will process the data on our behalf, we will conclude a processing agreement to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of the data, as required. We remain responsible for the processing by the parties that we have engaged.

Third-parties may also collect data through their apps, social media sites and websites for their own purposes. We are not responsible for the collection of such data and refer you to their privacy policies in this regard.

How long do we retain the data?

We do not retain the data longer than strictly necessary by us and/or required by Dutch law. We will delete the data when it is no longer needed for these purposes.

What about pictures and video recordings?

At the campsite of the Jambo and during activities outside the campsite, pictures and video recordings may be made for promotional purposes, which may be processed and shared via, among others, the website, social media and media (such as newspapers) and shown on screens during the Jambo.

By entering the campsite and participating in activities outside the campsite, you consent to the use of these pictures and video recordings for these purposes.

If you wish for a particular picture or video recording to be removed, please contact us via the contact details set out below.

We may, however, not be able to arrange for any pictures and video recordings that were shared via social media and media to be removed though.

What about the confidentiality and security of the data?

We take the protection of the data seriously and have taken appropriate organizational and technical measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification.

Only those persons for whom it is necessary by virtue of their position within the Foundation or the Jambo-organization are granted access to the data.

If you believe that your data is not properly (sufficiently) secured or there are indications of misuse, please contact us via the contact details set out below.

Please note that the Internet is never 100% secure. Be sure to take appropriate security measures yourself and never provide your password to anyone else.

Which choices and rights do you have?

- You may at any time request to look into or receive your data, modify it or have it modified or delete it or have it deleted.
- You may withdraw your previously given consent for processing your data at any time.
- You can also object to processing, restrict or transfer your data.

The above can be done as follows:

- You can modify the data in your Jambo-account.
- Use the option to unsubscribe from the mailing list at the bottom of every message you receive from us so that you will no longer receive information from us.
- You can contact us with a request, question and/or complaint by e-mail. In order to answer you we may ask you to identify yourself. This way we know for sure that you are the correct person whose data is involved. We will respond as soon as possible, but in any case within four weeks after receipt of your email.

Finally, you have the possibility to file a complaint about the processing of your data by us with the Dutch Data Protection Authority (*in Dutch: Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens*) via this link: <https://autoriteitpersoonsgegevens.nl/nl/contact-met-de-autoriteit-persoonsgegevens/tip-ons>.

Modification of the privacy statement

The Foundation reserves the right to amend this privacy statement. We encourage you to regularly review our privacy statement for changes. If we make significant changes to our privacy statement, we will inform you and in the case of significant changes, we will - if necessary - also ask your permission.
